

## **Engine Room Fire Prevention Checklist**

Proper maintenance is the key factor in avoiding engine room fires. Make a thorough inspection of the engine room and check that:

- 1. there is no hazardous leakage of oil in the machinery spaces of the ship;
- 2. the general standard of cleanliness in the machinery spaces is high;
- all pipes and fittings are in sound condition;
- all repairs carried out to oil pipes and fittings are of a permanent nature;
- **5.** all high-pressure fuel oil pipes are properly shielded;

- 6. insulation/lagging covers all hot surfaces;
- **7.** all readily combustible materials are stored only in designated areas;
- 8. the quick-closing valves are functioning;
- 9. the fire dampers are functioning;
- contactors and connections in electrical installations are in sound condition;
- 11. the engine room fire alarm is working and that the crew is well aware of the fire fighting and emergency procedures.
