## Coronavirus, COVID-19

*The following information was received from our correspondent on 21 May:*

### QUOTE

We would like to advise you that next week (starting from Sunday 24th of May till Thursday 28th of May) there will be a complete shutdown of all Egyptian Authorities, Banks and Governmental Agencies due to the Bayram Eid festivities and the nations efforts to flatten the curve of the possible stronger wave of COVID-19 cases Egypt is currently experiencing.

Moreover, during next week, a tougher curfew will be imposed from 5 pm till 6 am.

We are hopeful that this strong wave of COVID-19 will die out and that businesses which will begin opening starting 31st May, 2020 will see a normal resumption of business.
