*\* In order to facilitate the automatic processing of cross-border credit transfers the European Committee for Banking Standards has developed the International Bank Account Number (IBAN). The IBAN is a series of alphanumeric characters that uniquely identifies an account held at a bank anywhere in the world. The first two alphabetic characters identify the country (ISO-code) in which the account is held, next two digits are the check digits, and the final part of the IBAN is the domestic account number.*
