EBOLA SHIP REPORTING PROCEDURE GUIDELINE FOR SHIPPING AGENTS

In view of the threat posed by the outbreak of the Ebola Virus in some areas, shipping agents are required to submit the following information on all vessels arriving in Jamaican waters with immediate effect.

- Vessel's last 5 ports of call.
- Cases of illness and/or suspected cases of illness on board.
- Crew members/passengers who have signed on the vessel within the last
 21 days and the place of origin of crew/passenger.

This information is required 24 hours prior to the arrival of the vessel and should be submitted to the Kingston pilot office at dispatcher@portjam.com and Quarantine office at porthealthne@gmail.com

Vessels with health concerns may be taken to a Quarantine station for processing.
