## **REPORTS ON STOWAWAY INCIDENTS**

### **Annual statistics for the year 2014**

1 The Facilitation Committee, at its twenty-seventh session (6 to 10 September 1999), instructed the Secretariat to issue a statistical analysis of the reports received by the Organization for each calendar year on an annual basis (FAL 27/19, paragraphs 10.9 and 10.10).

2 Set out in the annex are the statistics for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2013, prepared on the basis of 61 incidents reported to the Organization, involving 120 stowaways.

3 In preparing the circular the Secretariat has noted that for some of the items listed, including the location of stowaways when found on board ships and the main categories of reasons for disembarkation, there was not sufficient information to allow detailed analysis.

4 From the information received and used for the analysis, the incidents occurred in 104 places of embarkation: 97 stowaways embarked in Africa; 5 in the Caribbean; 2 in Asia and 16 were not reported. There were 13 attempts of embarkation. Stowaways used 25 container' ships and 10 bulk carriers among other type of ships.


